Document Imaging & Translation Services

As a result of ICE's law enforcement activities, special agents seize or detain a wide variety of documents and media. Document Imaging and Translation Services provide support in the preparation of evidence documents and media to be electronically (digitally) shared with applicable U.S. and opposing attorneys in the prosecution of cases.

Document Imaging and Translation Services

performs digitization services to prepare case files and evidence for trial. Processing requirements against seized materials include scanning, digital imaging, optical character recognition, metadata extraction, verification, and data entry, plus Bates Numbering and translation from 64 languages into English for use in prosecution cases. The digital document images and data are then converted to Portable Document Format (PDF) files optimized for use in DHS and US Attorney systems using state-of-the-art software.
