THE PROJECT STORY

Eastern Virginia Medical School (EVMS) is a public medical school that serves the Hampton Roads community. EVMS is known for its strides in reproductive medicine and its leadership in community service and medical missions.

In 2008 EVMS needed to address the limited space allocated for on-site physical documents and sought out a vendor that could help them centralize and streamline information access across multiple departments.
